SHD 2021 Overview

- This year's SHD will be predominately an online event, like last year
- Homes will open virtually on the SHD website, requiring homeowners to create a video house tour (if you've already made one last year, this isn't required)
- Homeowners will be able to interact with SHD attendees via comments on your profiles, and will be required to spend a period of time on SHD (17 October) responding to comments on your profile.
- Renew will run a series of webinars in the lead up to SHD (17 October) and on SHD will run a day long webinar with homeowners, similar to the one we ran last year. We will recruit homeowners who are a good fit for these events.
- Community groups will also run their own virtual and in person events during the period of 20 September to 17 October. There may be opportunities for you to connect with these groups in your area

SHD 2021 Homeowner Timeline

- Homeowner applications are now open. Apply at sustainablehouseday.com/apply.
- **Homeowner applications close 1 June.** We would like your application forms complete by that date. We will let you know whether your application has been accepted on a rolling basis when your application form has been completed.
- **House video tours must be complete by 31 July.** We will be sharing the Video Resource Guide for this year shortly at sustainablehouseday.com/resources.
- House tour videos will go live on our website on 20 September.
- Virtual events commence on 21 September and run until 17 October.
